Students develop future-ready skills and master content in contextualized, client-driven work. At Arlington Tech, learning is not prescriptive, it's engaging, challenging and relevant.


**Arlington Tech is located at the Arlington Career Center campus**, where students have access to exceptional lab spaces and a variety of Career and Technical Education (CTE) courses.


Arlington Tech students earn Early College Credits
