21ST CENTURY SKILLS

The curriculum at Arlington Tech includes an explicit focus on **developing skills in Collaboration, Creativity, Critical Thinking, and Communication.**



PROJECT-BASED LEARNING

PBL is a **student-centered approach to learning in which students acquire a deeper knowledge of content and skills** through active exploration of real-world challenges and problems.



EARLY COLLEGE CREDITS

Students may earn college credit for a variety of CTE and academic classes.

By the 11th grade, all students will have the opportunity to take college level courses, allowing students to graduate with transferable college credits and a General Education Certificate from NVCC.



INDUSTRY CERTIFICATIONS

Students will earn an industry specific certification in a technical area of their choice. These certificates make students competitive as interns during their 12th grade capstone experience.

transcript of up to 30-40 college credits.
