As we prepare to transition into our summer break, it is important to remember that we, here at Arlington County Public Schools, are committed to your student(s) making smart and healthy decisions. The 100 days between Memorial Day and Labor Day are known as a very dangerous time due to frequent travel, youth being out of school, and increased drinking and driving.

Here are a few School's Out Summer Safety tips:

- We continue to see increased incidents of vaping (electronic cigarettes) amongst our teen population:
 - Pay attention to sweet smells, blood shot eyes, frequent trips to the bathroom, irritability
 - Look for vape related paraphernalia, such as: Juul pod, caps, pods, vape juice bottles, and empty vape devices.



- Other substances to be aware of: Alcohol, marijuana, THC Oil (Dab Pens), prescription medication (that does not belong to the youth), over-the-counter medication (when taken excessively).
